Lent is a good time to learn about Centering Prayer

Centering Prayer at All Saints' is another opportunity to deepen your relationship with God during Lent, or any season.

Mthr. Lynne Waltman began to facilitate Centering Prayer during the Lenten season last year, and has continued with it ever since at 7:45 a.m. every Thursday morning in the Vida and Francis Staff Chapel in the Gray House.

About Contemplative and Centering Prayer...

Contemplative Prayer is the opening of our whole self to God. It is coming into the presence of God and simply being present.

Centering Prayer is a method by which we can facilitate the development of Contemplative Prayer.

During Centering Prayer, we consent to God's presence and action within us. The experience of being in God's presence is different for each one of us so it's hard – perhaps impossible – to describe.

We explore being in the presence of God and developing a practice of prayer that will, by the grace of God, lead us to open our hearts and minds to God.

A normal prayer session begins with reading the upcoming Sunday Gospel, then sitting in silence for 20 minutes. We close with the Lord's Prayer.

Many women are already volunteers, but on this day, men are badly needed to provide physical help and also to bring a more balanced male/female presence at the event.

The event date is **Maundy Thursday, April 18**. We will be packing things and setting up starting around 8:30 a.m. We will be completely done no later than 3:00 p.m. Help is also needed in advance to prepare for the event, and cash donations are also welcomed.
