Reunification Between The Episcopal Diocese of Texas and The Episcopal Church in North Texas

July 11, 2022: Both the House of Bishops and House of Deputies of the Episcopal Church voted in favor of the reunification between The Episcopal Diocese of Texas and The Episcopal Church of North Texas at the 80th General Convention.

Bishop C. Andrew Doyle states: "Today is a great day in the Episcopal Diocese of Texas and now the work we have been called to do begins, and that is for us to reunite and do what God expects us to do. What an opportunity for us to engage our people in a bigger, deeper way. We will become even more involved in sharing the Good News with so many more people, helping our neighbors, reaching the unchurched, and so much more. We now have closure in this process and will realize extraordinary outcomes. We know that we are better and stronger together and we are so excited."
