
LET HEAVEN AND EARTH SING

Dr. Cynthia Hill began the study of Byzantine iconography in 2016 with Orthodox teachers of the Prosopon School, including its founder, Vladislav Andrejev and his son Dimitri. Dimitri wrote the double-sided icon which now serves as our second processional cross.

Icons are said to be the "Gospel in color." While traditional iconography remains within the bounds of unspoken canon, today's icons reflect the inner mysterious depth of tradition and clothe the eternal in new forms.

WESTAID

West Fort Worth's "Pantry with a Purpose" serves 150-320 families weekly.

Did you know that there is a food pantry on the Westside of Fort Worth which has been in existence for 37 years? Did you know that food pantry has served over 10,000 families and has distributed over 2,800,000 lbs. of food since the pandemic began?

WestAid serves three zip codes -- 76107, 76116 and 76126, along with a few areas of 76109 and 76008. The organization serves more than 30,000 people annually. Tarrant County ranks among the top 10 counties in the U.S. for food-insecure people, with a rate of 18.5 percent, compared with 15.9 percent nationally. In WestAid's service area, 10 of 13 elementary school's student bodies are without food on a regular basis.

WestAid began in the basement of Ridglea Presbyterian Church in 1985. It outgrew that space and relocated to the Viola Pitts JPS center and was in that location until 2011. In 2011, the JPS facility needed the space, and WestAid relocated to 7940 Camp Bowie West, its present location. Due to space limitations and increasing need for services, WestAid is once again looking for a new home.

The organization is supported by several westside churches (including All Saints'), and by individual donations, as well as several foundations and the Emergency Food and Shelter Program. The future looks bright for WestAid as the good work continues and as the search for a larger location begins.

All Saints' has partnered with WestAid since its inception, sending both volunteers and financial support as needed.


