*Officiant and People*

#### **O Gracious Light** *Phos hilaron*

O gracious Light,  
pure brightness of the everliving Father in heaven,  
O Jesus Christ, holy and blessed!

Now as we come to the setting of the sun,  
and our eyes behold the vesper light,  
we sing thy praises, O God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Thou art worthy at all times to be praised by happy voices,  
O Son of God, O Giver of life,  
and to be glorified though all the worlds.

#### **Psalm 111** *Confitebor tibi*

1 Hallelujah!  
I will give thanks to the LORD with my whole heart, \*  
in the assembly of the upright, in the congregation.

2 Great are the deeds of the LORD! \*  
they are studied by all who delight in them.

3 His work is full of majesty and splendor, \*  
and his righteousness endures for ever.

4 He makes his marvelous works to be remembered; \*  
the LORD is gracious and full of compassion.

5 He gives food to those who fear him; \*  
he is ever mindful of his covenant.

- 6 He has shown his people the power of his works \*  
in giving them the lands of the nations.
- 7 The works of his hands are faithfulness and justice; \*  
all his commandments are sure.
- 8 They stand fast for ever and ever, \*  
because they are done in truth and equity.
- 9 He sent redemption to his people;  
he commanded his covenant for ever; \*  
holy and awesome is his Name.
- 10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; \*  
those who act accordingly have a good  
understanding;  
his praise endures for ever.

**Psalm 112**    *Beatus vir*

- 1 Hallelujah!  
Happy are they who fear the Lord \*  
and have great delight in his commandments!
- 2 Their descendants will be mighty in the land; \*  
the generation of the upright will be blessed.
- 3 Wealth and riches will be in their house, \*  
and their righteousness will last for ever.
- 4 Light shines in the darkness for the upright; \*  
the righteous are merciful and full of compassion.
- 5 It is good for them to be generous in lending \*  
and to manage their affairs with justice.
- 6 For they will never be shaken; \*  
the righteous will be kept in everlasting remembrance.
- 7 They will not be afraid of any evil rumors; \*  
their heart is right;  
they put their trust in the Lord.

- 8 Their heart is established and will not shrink, \*  
until they see their desire upon their enemies.
  
- 9 They have given freely to the poor, \*  
and their righteousness stands fast for ever;  
they will hold up their head with honor.
  
- 10 The wicked will see it and be angry;  
they will gnash their teeth and pine away; \*  
the desires of the wicked will perish.

**Psalm 113**    *Laudate, pueri*

- 1 Hallelujah!  
Give praise, you servants of the LORD; \*  
praise the Name of the LORD.
  
- 2 Let the Name of the LORD be blessed, \*  
from this time forth for evermore.
  
- 3 From the rising of the sun to its going down \*  
let the Name of the LORD be praised.
  
- 4 The LORD is high above all nations, \*  
and his glory above the heavens.
  
- 5 Who is like the LORD our God, who sits enthroned on high, \*  
but stoops to behold the heavens and the earth?
  
- 6 He takes up the weak out of the dust \*  
and lifts up the poor from the ashes.
  
- 7 He sets them with the princes, \*  
with the princes of his people.
  
- 8 He makes the woman of a childless house \*  
to be a joyful mother of children.

## The Lessons

*Officiant      A Reading from the Book of Numbers  
                  Chapter 27 verses 12 through 23*

<sup>12</sup> The LORD said to Moses, “Go up into this mountain of Ab’arim, and see the land which I have given to the people of Israel. <sup>13</sup> And when you have seen it, you also shall be gathered to your people, as your brother Aaron was gathered, <sup>14</sup> because you rebelled against my word in the wilderness of Zin during the strife of the congregation, to sanctify me at the waters before their eyes.” (These are the waters of Mer’ibah of Kadesh in the wilderness of Zin.) <sup>15</sup> Moses said to the LORD, <sup>16</sup> “Let the LORD, the God of the spirits of all flesh, appoint a man over the congregation, <sup>17</sup> who shall go out before them and come in before them, who shall lead them out and bring them in; that the congregation of the LORD may not be as sheep which have no shepherd.” <sup>18</sup> And the LORD said to Moses, “Take Joshua the son of Nun, a man in whom is the spirit, and lay your hand upon him; <sup>19</sup> cause him to stand before Elea’zar the priest and all the congregation, and you shall commission him in their sight. <sup>20</sup> You shall invest him with some of your authority, that all the congregation of the people of Israel may obey. <sup>21</sup> And he shall stand before Elea’zar the priest, who shall inquire for him by the judgment of the Urim before the LORD; at his word they shall go out, and at his word they shall come in, both he and all the people of Israel with him, the whole congregation.” <sup>22</sup> And Moses did as the LORD commanded him; he took Joshua and caused him to stand before Elea’zar the priest and the whole congregation, <sup>23</sup> and he laid his hands upon him, and commissioned him as the LORD directed through Moses.

*Officiant*      A Reading from the Gospel of Mark  
*Chapter 1 verses 14 through 20*

<sup>14</sup> Now after John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of God, <sup>15</sup> and saying, “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent, and believe in the gospel.”  
<sup>16</sup> And passing along by the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and Andrew the brother of Simon casting a net in the sea; for they were fishermen. <sup>17</sup> And Jesus said to them, “Follow me and I will make you become fishers of men.” <sup>18</sup> And immediately they left their nets and followed him. <sup>19</sup> And going on a little farther, he saw James the son of Zeb’edee and John his brother, who were in their boat mending the nets. <sup>20</sup> And immediately he called them; and they left their father Zeb’edee in the boat with the hired servants, and followed him.

sleep. Tend the sick, Lord Christ; give rest to the weary, bless  
the dying, soothe the suffering, pity the afflicted, shield the  
joyous; and all for thy love's sake. *Amen.*

A Collect for the Unity of the Human Family

O God, thou hast made us in thine own image and redeemed us  
through thy Son Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace: Give us grace  
seriously to lay to heart the great dangers we are in by our unhappy  
and unjust divisions; look with compassion on the whole human  
family; take away the arrogance and hatred which infect our hearts;  
break down the walls that separate us; and work through our struggles

and confusion to accomplish thy purposes on earth; that we may be united in one holy bond of truth, and justice, peace, and love; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
