Keeping the Feast: Journeys to Jerusalem with John's Jesus

The Gospel of John is well known for its unique presentation of Jesus. But the Fourth Gospel has some other unusual features as well. John presents the main events of Jesus' life in a different order than the other Gospels. And, unlike the Jesus found in the other Gospels, John's Jesus spends most of his time, not in Galilee, but in the holy city Jerusalem, celebrating the great pilgrimage festivals of the Jewish liturgical year.
