## 174<sup>th</sup> Episcopal Diocese of Texas Council

All Saints' and other Fort Worth area Episcopal churches were welcomed into the Diocese of Texas with a resounding standing ovation at the 174th Council of the Episcopal Diocese of Texas (EDOT), held in Galveston on February 24th and 25th. Bishop Doyle and roughly 1,000 delegates and clergy conducted the business of the diocese, approving the budget and electing leaders. Council also eagerly celebrated Fort Worth's reunification with EDOT with the ringing of the mission bell. This bell is rung each time a new worshipping community joins the diocese. In addition to Bishop Doyle's heartfelt welcome and poignant praise for the sacrifice and dedication of North Region churches, Bishop Scott Mayer and Bishop Rayford High shared an emotional tribute and endorsement of the reunification. All Saints' was represented by delegates **Melanie Brown, Barbara Chowning, Laura Fleming, and Andrew Johnsen.**
