On the Feast of Pentecost, we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit. On the first Christian Pentecost, after the Holy Spirit descended upon the heads of the disciples as tongues of fire, the disciples preached the Gospel in tongues and were miraculously understood by people from across the world. Regardless of their nationality, each one heard the Good News through the power of the Spirit. In that moment, the Church was born. Two thousand years later, the Church continues, and we are also sent out to preach the Gospel in the power of the Spirit.

Join us this year on **Sunday, May 19**, in the All Saints' Episcopal School Chapel for Pentecost. There will be a combined Solemn Festival Eucharist at 10:00 a.m. with Holy Baptisms. Following the 10:00 a.m. service, we will gather in the Student Union for a birthday party for the church, where Mthr. Hill will teach the story of Pentecost.

Later that evening at 5:00 p.m., please join us for a very special Solemn Evensong. Our organist and choirmaster, Clive Diskill-Smith has invited the choir from St. Stephen Presbyterian Church to join the All Saints' Choir for one night only! They will be singing the Magnificat and Nunc Dimittis in B minor by Thomas Tertius Noble, and the anthem *O Thou Who Camest From Above* by Philip Stopford. The combined choir will contain over 30 choir members.

Following Solemn Evensong, the Parish Life Commission will host a reception in the Student Union.
